Global Competencies Hub for Logic IC Assembly & Testing

Singapore is the lead backend testing and assembly site for Logic IC operations in Asia-Pacific. The 380,000 sq ft facility in Kallang is responsible for the assembly and final testing of logic IC products, such as microcontroller, signal processors, power ICs, high frequency ICs and consumer ICs.

Supported by more than over 1500 employees, it achieved 1 billion ICs shipped in year 2004.

Its testing competencies include wafer testing capabilities.

Global Competencies Hub for R&D

Singapore is the key R&D hub for IC product design and development, as well as the home to the Assembly & Interconnect Technology Development Centre in Asia Pacific.

The Microelectronics Design Centre is the first to be established outside Europe and has over 200 IC design engineers engaging in the research and development of logic ICs, microcontrollers and communications products.


As the main Assembly & Interconnect Technology Development centre, it is also presently the package development competence centre for Logic, Power and Discretes segments.

Logistics Hub for Asia

Singapore serves as the distribution centre to support customer order management and delivery fulfillment to

customers based in Asia Pacific and the Asia Pacific operations of European and Japanese customers.

Milestones

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- 1970 Infineon Technologies Asia Pacific Pte Ltd, known then as Siemens Components Pte Ltd, has grown and expanded in tandem with the Singapore economy.
- 1995 Infineon Technologies received the Business Headquarters Award from the Economic Development Board of Singapore.
- 1999 Infineon Technologies AG was born, pursuant to the worldwide spin-off from Siemens AG. Siemens Components Pte Ltd was renamed as Infineon Technologies Asia Pacific Pte Ltd.
- 2000 Infineon Technologies AG was listed on the stock exchanges of Frankfurt and New York.
- 2005 Infineon Technologies Asia Pacific Pte Ltd reached an accumulated investment of One Billion Singapore dollars in Singapore.
- Opening of new Headquarters for Asia Pacific at 8 Kallang Sector.
- 2006 Carve-out and IPO of its memory products business group, Qimonda, headquartered in Munich.
- 2007 Expansion of R&D operations in Singapore where Infineon plans to spend approximately 400 Million Singapore Dollars and add about 150 new positions in R&D over the next three years.
