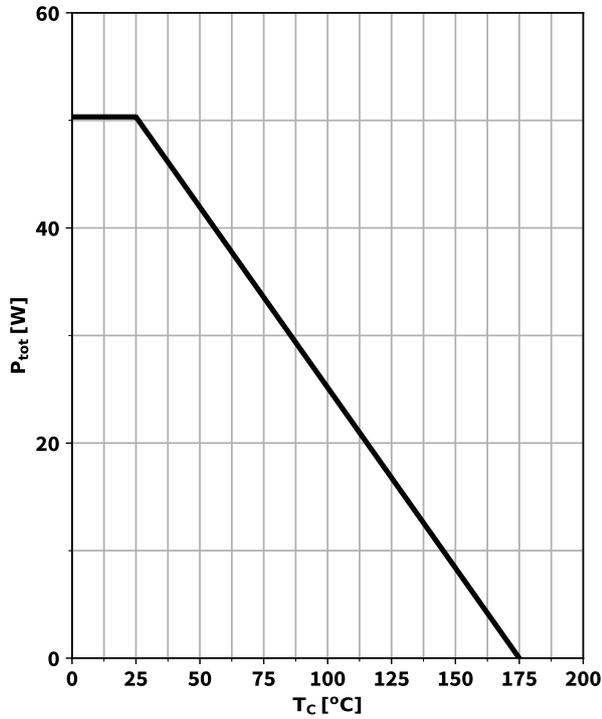

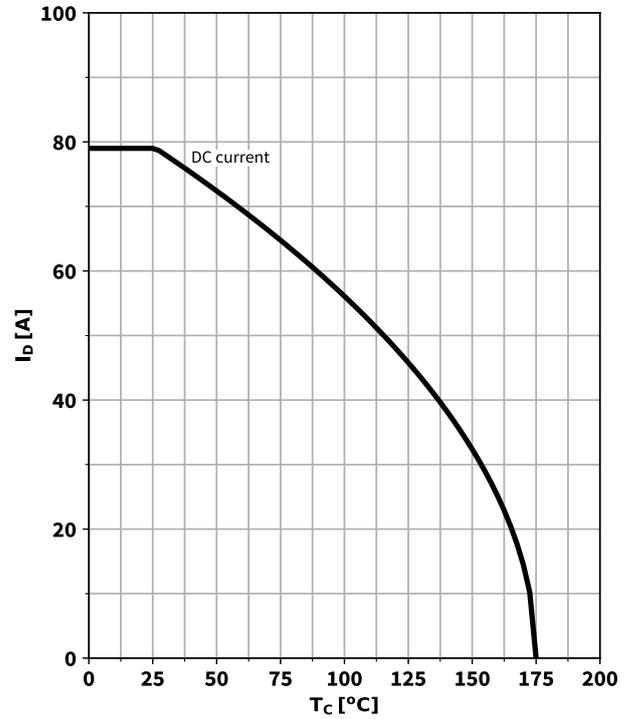
1 Power dissipation

$$P_{tot} = f(T_C); V_{GS} \geq 6 \text{ V}$$



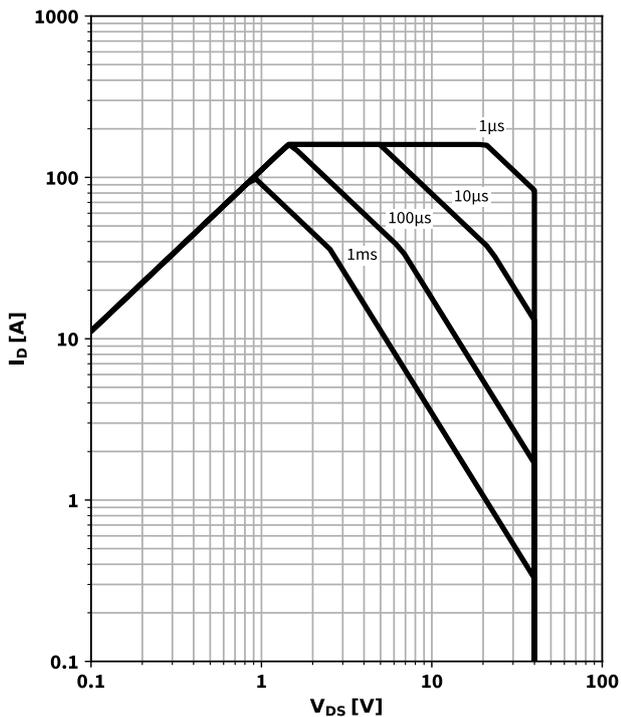
2 Drain current

$$I_D = f(T_C); V_{GS} \geq 6 \text{ V}$$



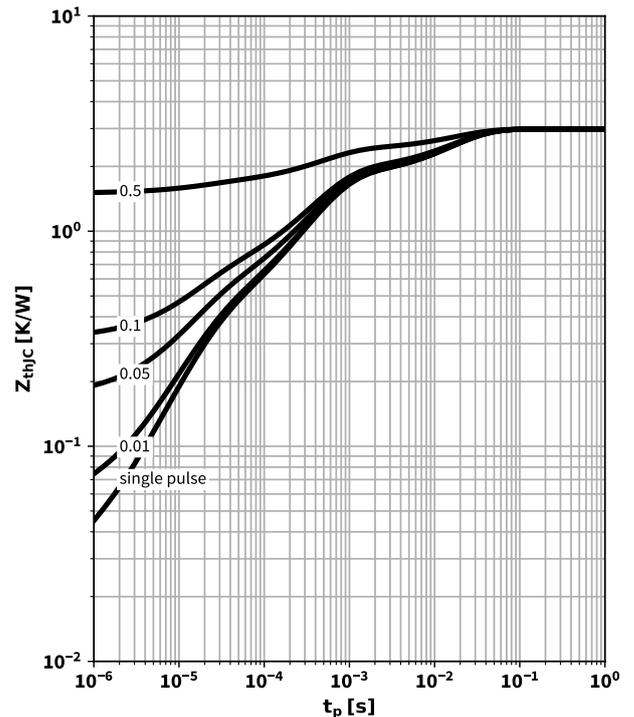
3 Safe operating area

$$I_D = f(V_{DS}); T_C = 25 \text{ °C}; D = 0; \text{ parameter: } t_p$$



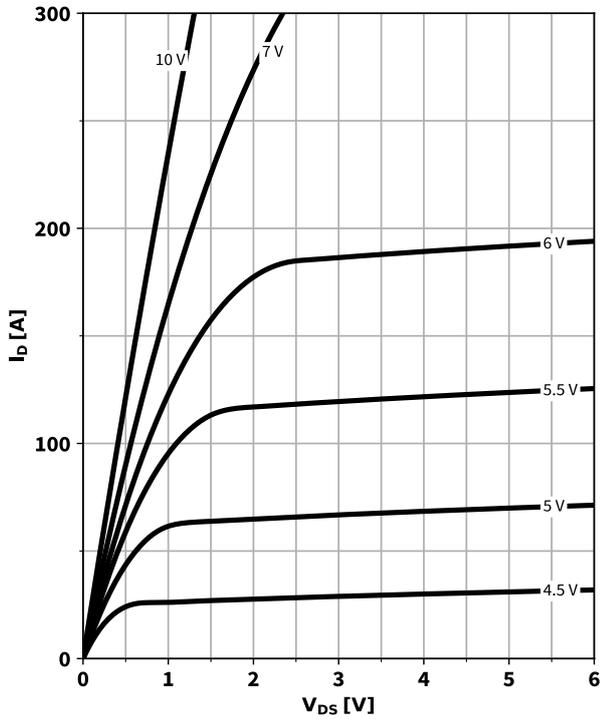
4 Max. transient thermal impedance

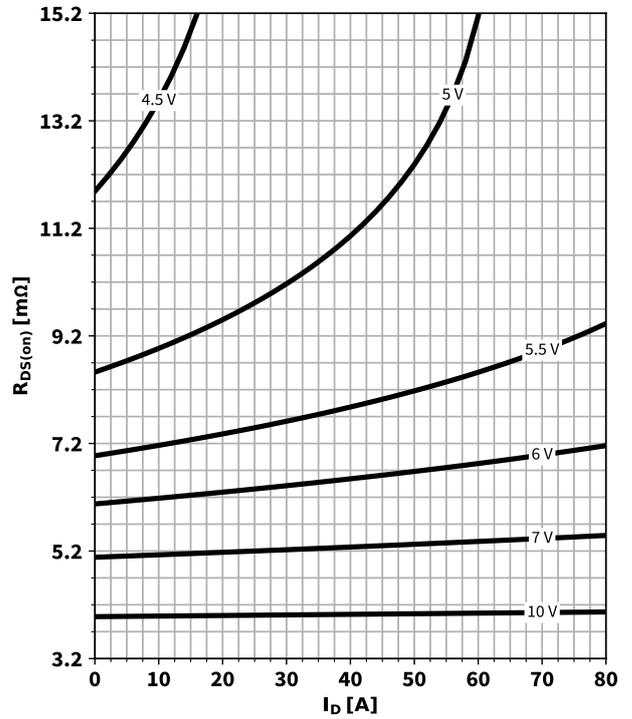
5 Typ. output characteristics

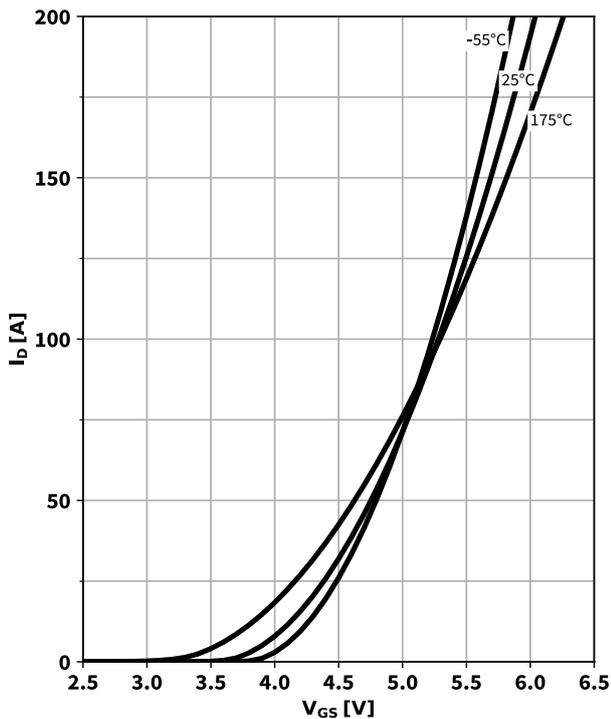
6 Typ. drain-source on-state resistance

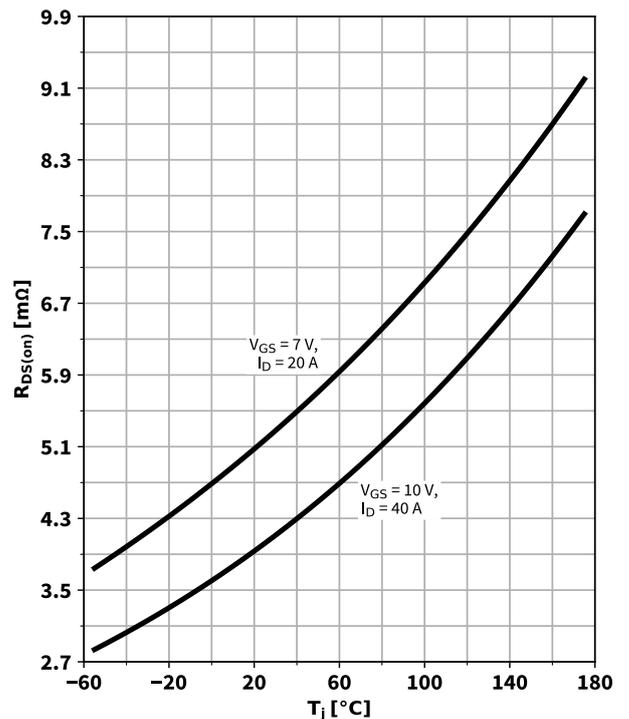

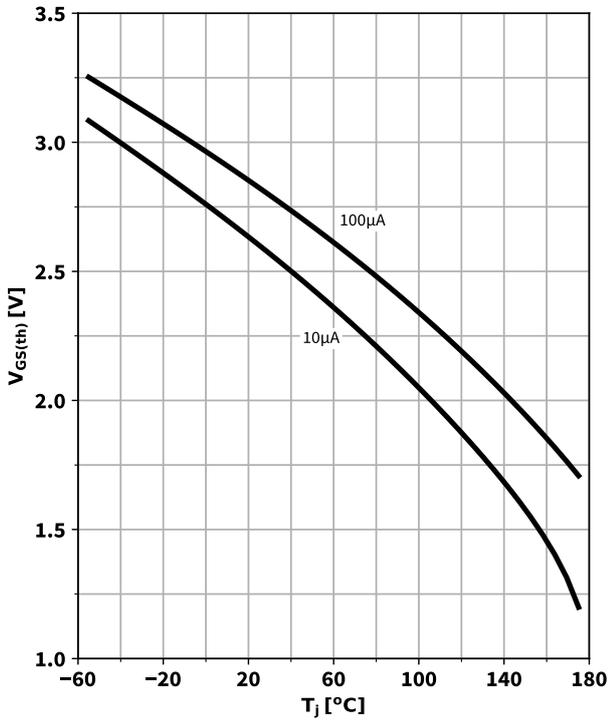

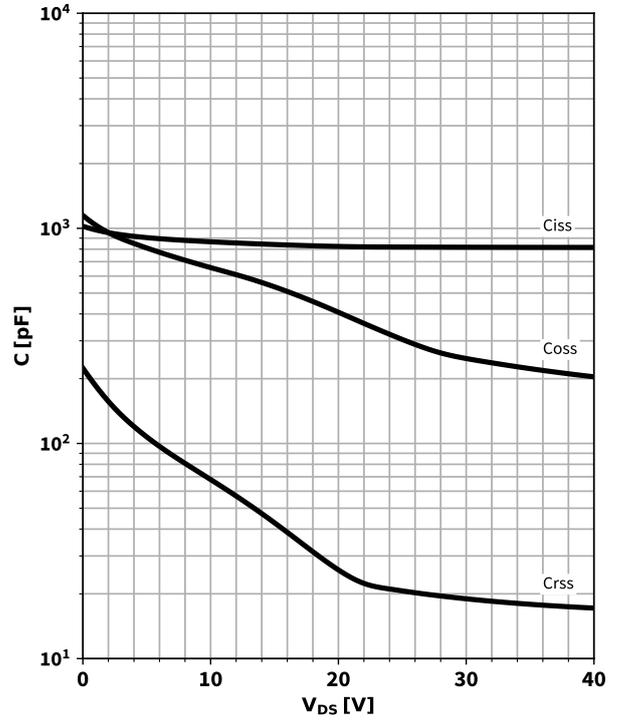
9 Typ. gate threshold voltage

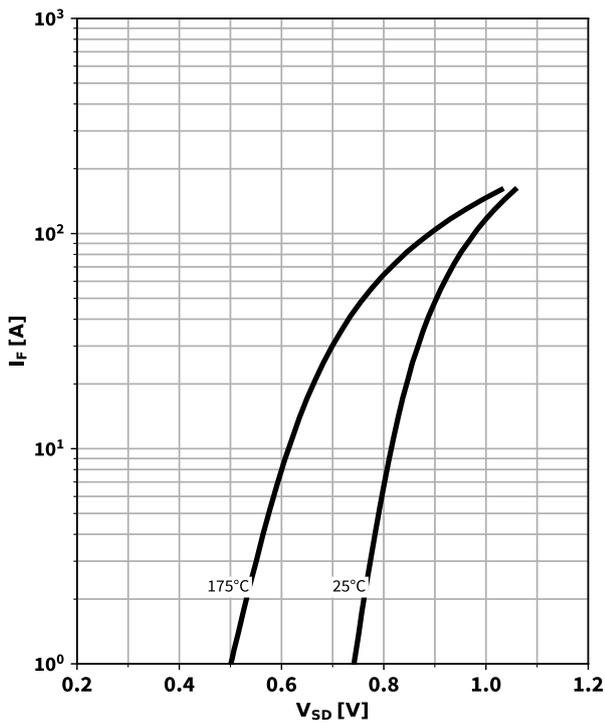

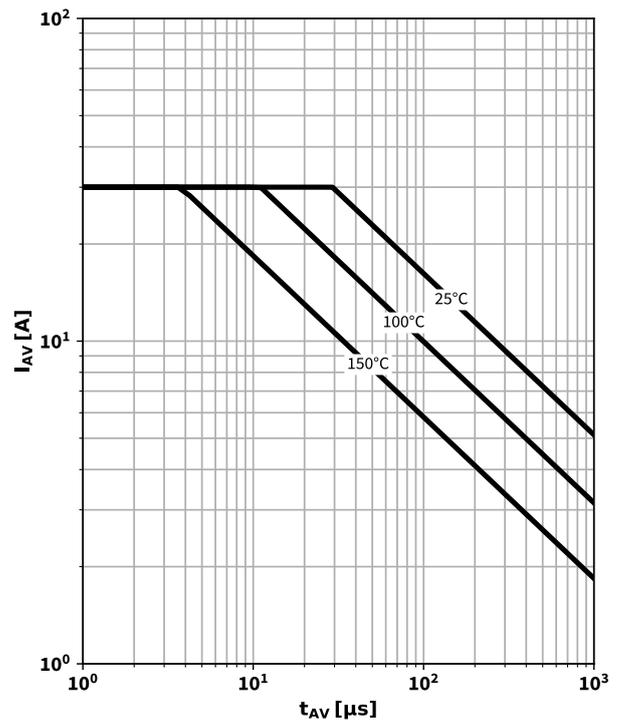

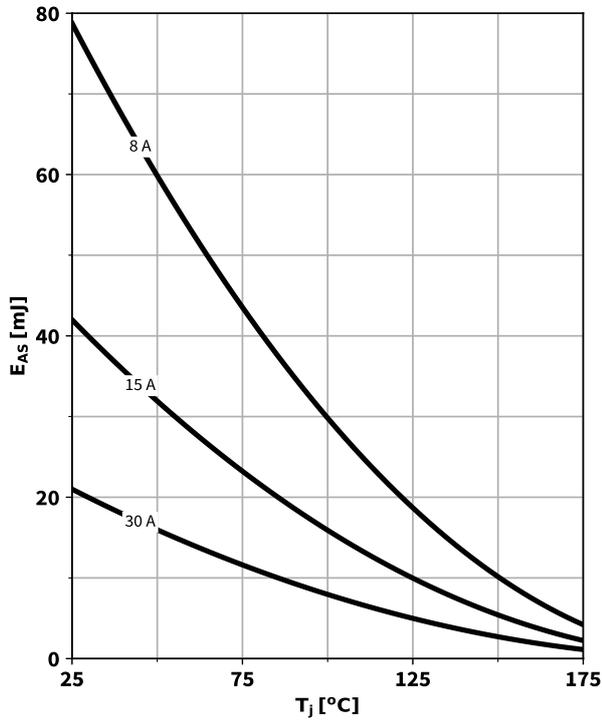

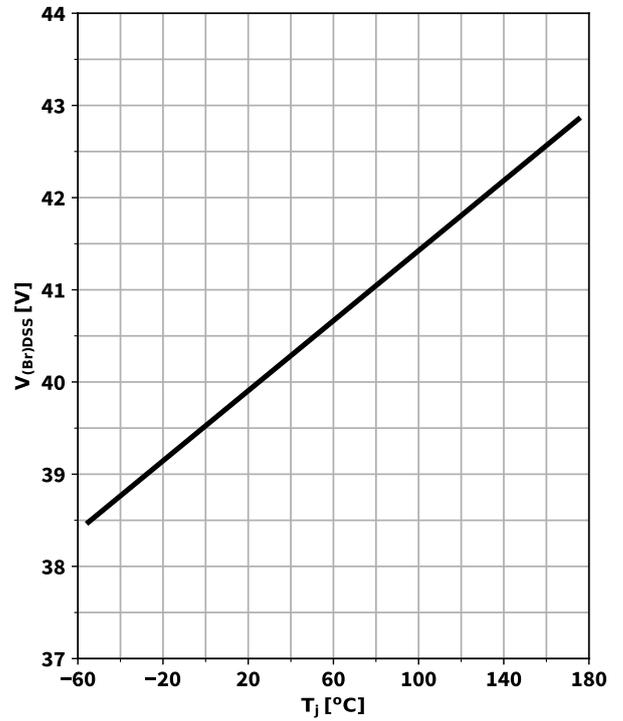
13 Typical avalanche energy

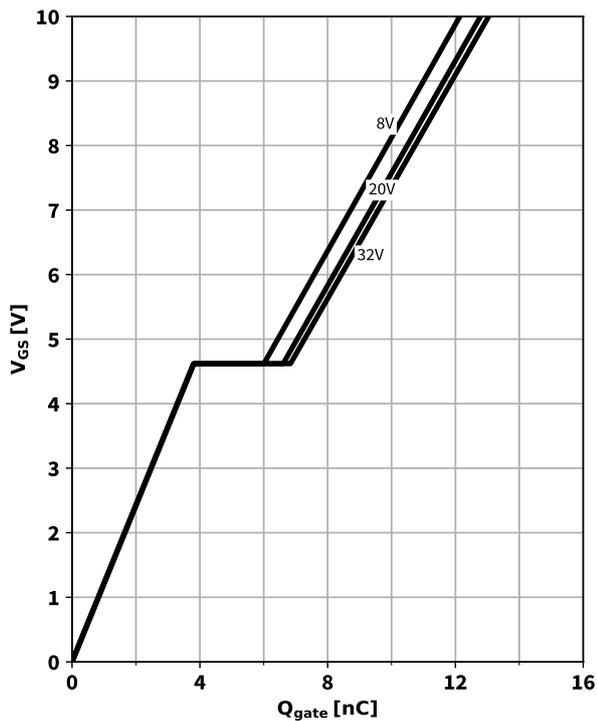
14 Drain-source breakdown voltage

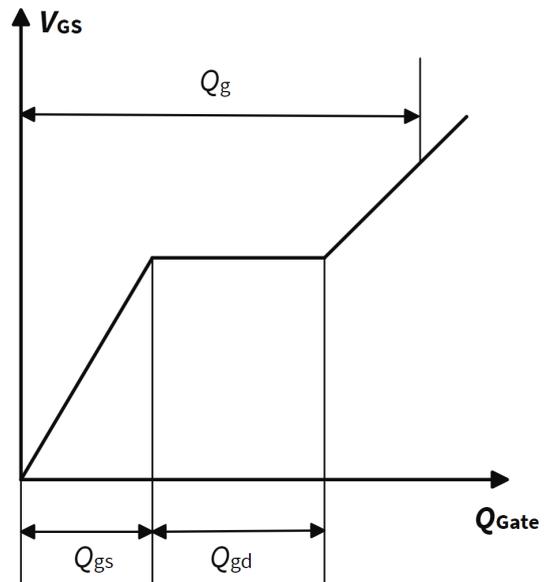


15 Typ. gate charge

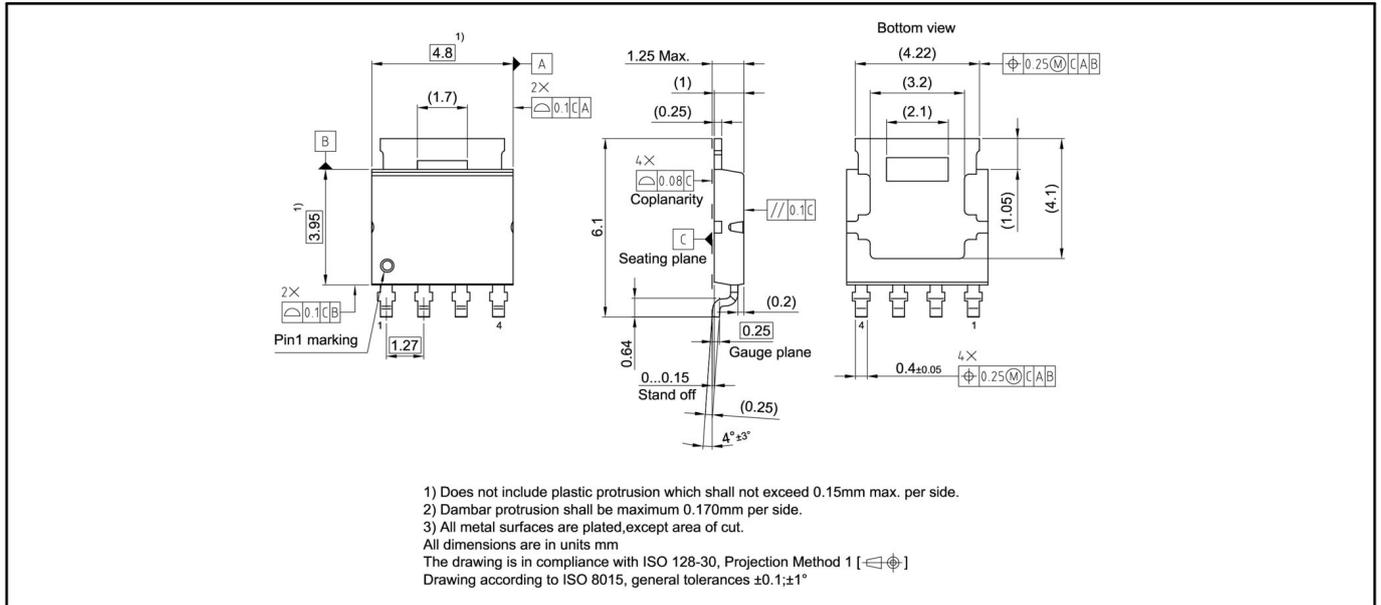

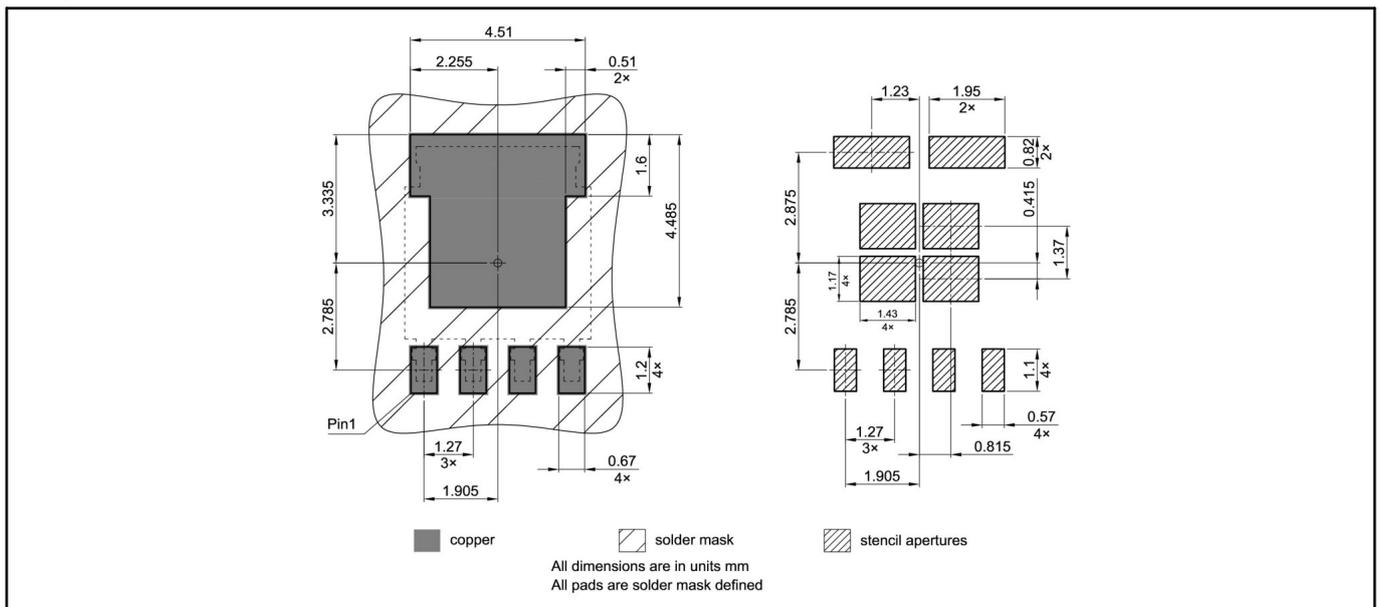
16 Gate charge waveforms



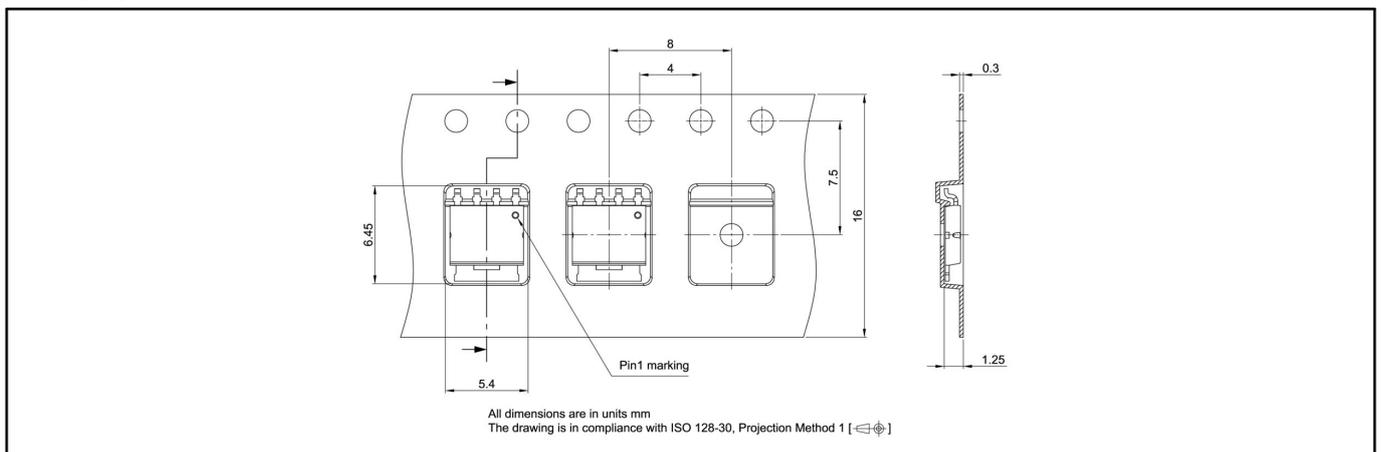
