- Work within change management guidelines ensuring all transports moved into production maintain system integrity.
- Create/maintain user roles and authorizations based on business needs. Administer and maintain end user accounts, permissions and access rights. Triage issues for role authorizations and associated T-codes.
- Deploy the SAP ARIBA IT solution to Infineon locations by onboarding old and new suppliers to ARIBA
- Engage and follow up with suppliers to enroll and enhance the SAP ARIBA solution, keep track onboarding deadlines for supplier enablement to ensure project timelines are met.
- Align and drive with the Software provider of ARIBA the process of supplier onboarding.
