THE BTS3205 is a monolithic, one-channel, self-protected, low-side switch in PG-DSO-8 package. In brief, it contains a N-channel MOSFET and the additional protection circuitry. The thermo shutdown with auto restart feature provides protection of the controlled loads.

The device provides protection against over-temperature, short-circuits, and over-voltage. Additionally its input pins are ESD protected.

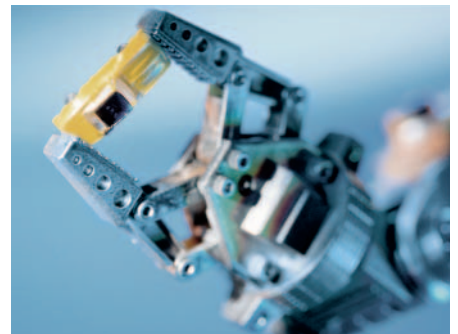

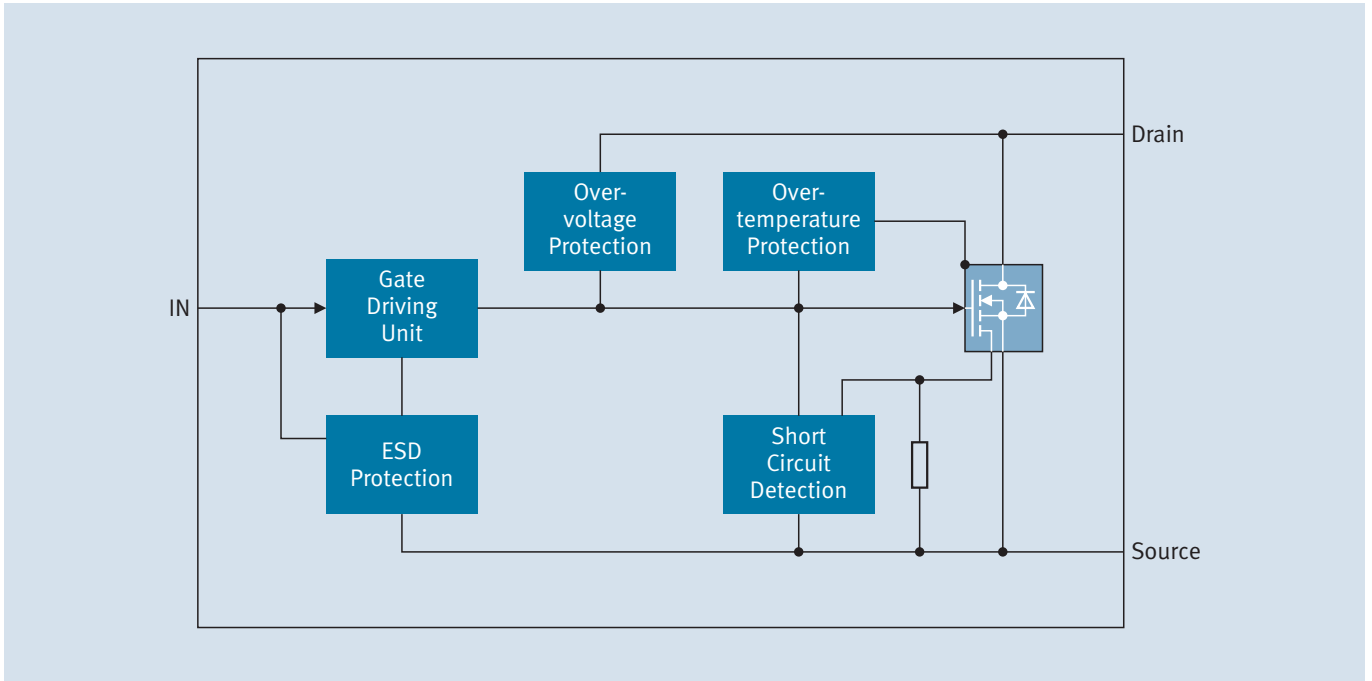

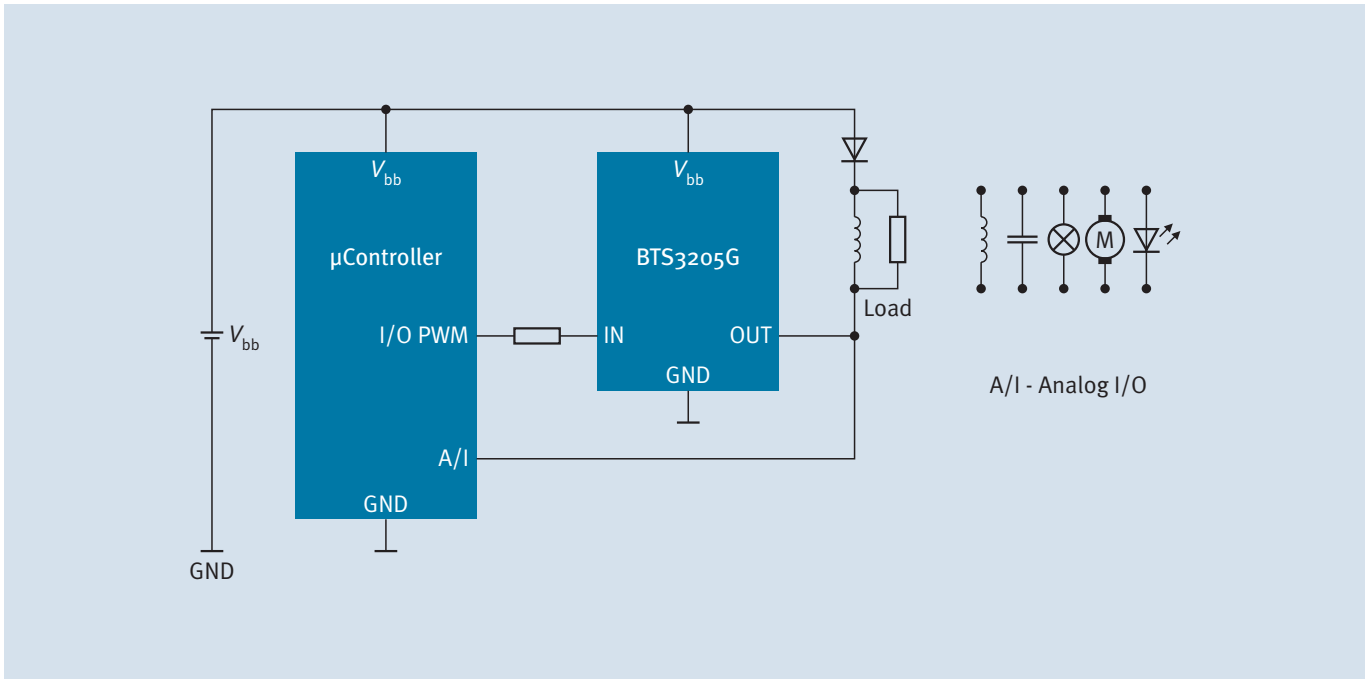


Never stop thinking
