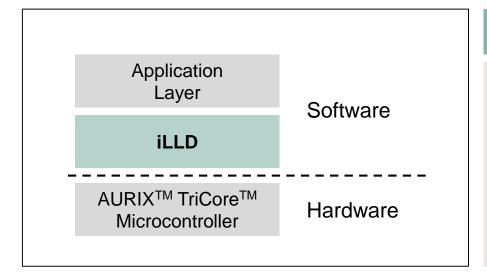

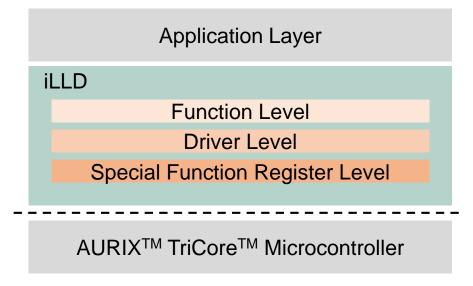

 The iLLD provides functions, drivers and structures that allow three levels of abstraction



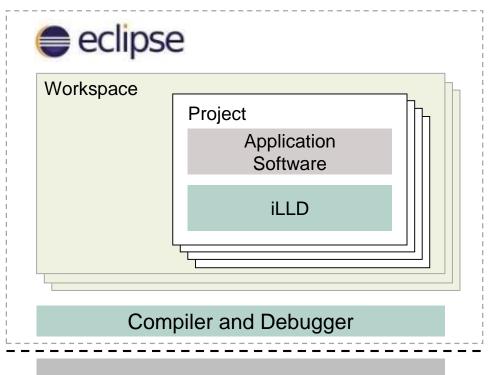
- Special Function Register Level: Access register bitfields by name

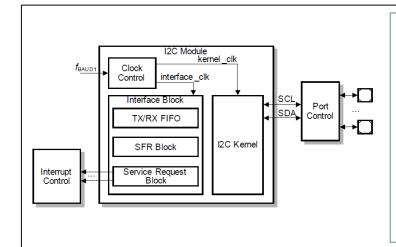
